REQUIREMENTS FOR ARTICLES

The article should not exceed 5– 15 pages. The article should be typewritten in A4 format. Reviewed and meeting the requirements articles will be published in the conference articles collection.

The application form and article annotation (should not exceed 100 words) in English must be sent by **October 21th 2013**. The article must be sent to rasa@kolping.lt, konferencija@kolping.lt and info@bmda.net by **October 28th, 2013**. **Only reviewed articles will be published.**

LAYOUT REQUIREMENTS

Text editor: MS Word, Times New Roman; margins: top and bottom 2 cm, left 3 cm, right 1,5 cm. Each paragraph should start with 1 cm indentation. Spaces between lines – 1,5.

STRUCTURE OF THE ARTICLE

- * **Title of the article** (all caps, centred, bold, 14 pt)
- * **Author's name, surname** (all caps, centred, bold, italic, 12 pt)
- * **Name of the college, school or university** (centred, 12 pt, Normal)
- * **Consultant (professor)** (centred, 12 pt, Normal)
- * **Annotation** (up to 100 words, italic, 11 pt, there should be title, institution, author and annotation text in the annotation)
- * **Introduction, chapters and conclusions** (title bold, text 12 pt, Normal, alignment left; with 1 cm indentation)
- * **Tables** (title (10 pt, bold, centred) should be above the table; Arabic numbering should be used; table with 10 pt, Normal)
- * **Pictures** (Pictures titles (10 pt, bold, centred), should be typewritten under the pictures).
- * **Formulas** (formulas have to be formatted with equation editor of MS Word, have to be numbered, 10 pt)
- * **References and literature list** (have to be formatted according to APA (American Psychological Association) standards (look to the attachments); title bold, text Normal, 11 pt)
