


Functional approach to the management

Functional Provide what client needs

- Relevance in program design
- Interactive teaching vs. “Traditional” teaching
- Applicability of research outcomes for Corporate partners and students
- “What is needed” rather than “What we are having” approach
- Sharing experiences with Community

Organic


Integrate and create a climate of cooperation
