competences of the specialists in the respective field with the objective to increase the competences and competitiveness of production enterprises. In 2011, a research on the operative level of production management was conducted, which demonstrated that the awareness level of the area is mediocre and that there are notable shortcomings in

the monitoring of production processes and effective use of production equipment. Insufficient specialised education, insufficient further education and insufficient professional literature were pointed out as the reasons.
