Continued from page 1 Apart from other association activities, this year has also been fruitful with memorable events. Traditionally, the most significant of them all was the BMDA Annual Conference, which was the 11th of such kind organized by BMDA. The conference gathered more than 120 participants from 16 countries in order to research and discuss the issues of management role for sustainable innovations and creative solutions.

To satisfy the needs of its wide and diverse members' audience, BMDA had numerous successful collaborative events. On 8 May, the joined conference "From Cooperation to Partnership" was organized by BMDA and Russian Association of Business Education (RABE), which took place in Vilnius, Lithuania. To provide the academic community with opportunities to improve and update the academic writing skills, the seminar "How to Get a Research Paper Published" took place on 26-27 September. The event was organized in collaboration with ISM University of Management and economics, and led by Prof. Christopher J. Brewster who has a wide experience and deep knowledge in article publishing and editing procedures for various academic journals.

Aiming to encourage and promote new methods and ideas in management of business schools, the training "Adizes Theory and Practice for the Best Business Schools" took place in Istanbul, Turkey on 7-9 November. The training was the result of a very successful collaboration between Adizes Graduate School, BMDA, CEEMAN, and RABE associations.

In order to develop management education among the future management professionals, the 2nd international Under-graduate student conference "Theory and Practice: Student Insights" was organized in collaboration with Kolping University of Applied Sciences on 14 November in Kaunas, Lithuania. The conference, which has become a traditional collaboration event between Kolping University of Applied Sciences and BMDA, attracted more than 50 your researchers from 7 countries, and we expect even greater interest from the young researchers for the coming year.

Throughout the year 2013, BMDA has been active in ongoing global events and activities. BMDA President Dr. Virginijus Kundrotas represented BMDA in the key events and meetings, such as EFMD Deans and Directors Meeting in Istanbul, Turkey; EQUAL Board meetings in Brussels, Belgium, and Madrid, Spain; International Symposium organized by European League for Economic Cooperation (elec) in Yerevan, Armenia, 21st Annual CEEMAN Conference in Bled, Slovenia; 6th Eduniversal World Convention in Bangalore, India; International conference "Entrepreneurship and Business Education in Emerging World", dedicated to the 25th Anniversary of International Academy of Business in Almaty, Kazakhstan, and number of other events.

In addition to this, BMDA sent its representative to the Nordplus programe contact seminar in Stockholm, Sweden. During the event important contacts were made with partners for the future projects of BMDA.

The year 2013 brought changes to the Association management. The BMDA Project manager position was taken over by Ms. Rima Mockeviciute, while former BMDA coordinator Ms. Goda Nevidauskiene was re-appointed to her former position in addition to her current position as the Project manager for Adizes Institute for West Europe and Baltics.

And least but not last, having had a year this fulfilling, we would like to share our sincere gratitude to all the BMDA members and friends. Thank you for being with us, for your ideas, initiatives, as well as skills, knowledge, and dedicated work to make it all happen. 
